THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH that, whereas the above bounden William Doobson has this day applied to the Clerk of the County Court of Hempstead County, for a License authorizing the solemnization of the Rite of Matrimony between the said William Doobson and Miss Amanda E. Hamiton. Now, if the said parties applying for said License have a lawful right to the same, and if they shall faithfully carry into effect and comply with the provisions thereof, and shall, within sixty days from the date hereof, return the said License to the office of the Clerk of the County Court of said County, duly executed and officially signed by some one authorized by law to solemnize the Rite of Matrimony, then this obligation shall be void, but otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
